# 5. New Species of Slime Mould - Badhamia foliicola

George first spotted the slime mould on the Willow base of the table outside Eskrigg Centre. At that stage the plasmodia were bright yellow in colour. By Hogmanay (after two days) bright purple sporangia had formed and the slime mould had started to release spores. This is the seventh species of slime mould identified at the Reserve.
